COURSE INFORMATION

Description: Creating a cybersecurity program touches on people, processes and technology. All are necessary for an effective program. Although cybersecurity is a risk-management strategy that belongs to everyone, IT is responsible for its successful implementation and evaluation. This workshop focuses on the specific needs of electric co-ops when developing and evaluating a program.

Discussion topics will include:

- The types of sensitive data that a co-op stores, processes or transmits.
- Where sensitive data is (or should be) stored and protected.
- Managing inventory of all hardware and software devices.
- Best practices for internal training to employees on cyber security.
- Implementing multi-factor authentication to protect your data and systems.
- Creating strategic vs. tactical security policies and procedures.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of their co-op's cybersecurity program.
- Share the cybersecurity tools and methodologies with coworkers and managers throughout all co-op departments.
- Identify long-term cybersecurity needs and solutions as well as be responsive to immediate threats.
