COURSE INFORMATION

Description: This session focuses on the practical and essential tools needed to protect your cooperative. In a hands-on lab environment, participants will learn how to penetration test using industry standard cybersecurity methodologies and tools. The workshop will also cover incident response and a real-life scenario tabletop exercise.

Topics will include:

- An introduction to basic penetration testing skills and incident response.
- Tools that penetration testers use like Metasploit, Nessus and Discovery.
- Responding to a breach and preparation for incident response (IR).
- Documentation review of IR, security operations, policies and procedures and compliance requirements.
- Security operations review, personnel review and IR process review.
- IR tabletop exercise.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Use the tools provided to perform some basic cybersecurity penetration testing.
- Test out the cooperative IR plan to assess its efficacy in protecting systems, employees and members.
- Review, assess and advise on documentation and processes to ensure security and compliance.
